The state of Montana is preparing to issue their summer food benefits programs. Summer EBT is for students who are eligible to receive free and reduced-priced meals through the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program. The summer EBT program provides grocery-buying benefits to families with schoolaged children when schools are closed for the summer. Beginning in summer 2024, families can receive \$40 per eligible child during the summer months of June, July, and August. Families that are not currently receiving free or reduced-price meal benefits but want to participate in Summer EBT should complete an application and return it to the school for eligibility determination.
