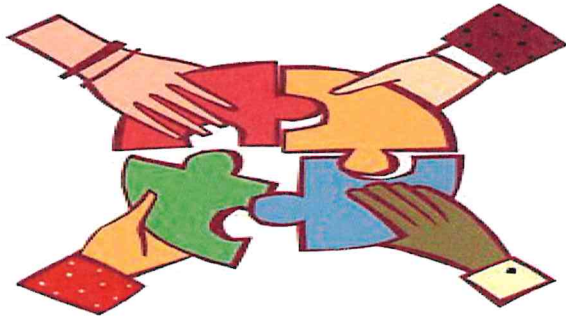

Library books must be returned during the week of May 28th.

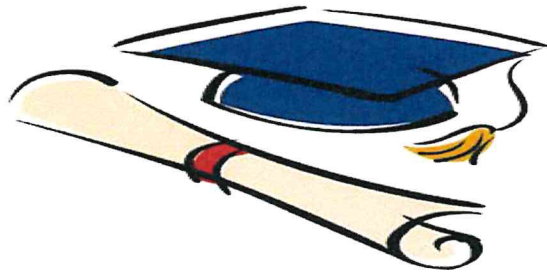


All library books and school fines (this includes lunches, unpaid skiing money, uniforms, etc.) are due May 30th.

The State of Montana is preparing to issue their summer Food Benefits Programs. Summer EBT is for students who are eligible to receive free and reduced-price meals through the National Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program. The Summer EBT program provides grocery-buying benefits to families with school-aged children when schools are closed for the summer. Beginning in summer 2024, families can receive \$40 per eligible child during the summer months of June, July, and August. Families that are not currently receiving free or reduced-price meal benefits but want to participate in Summer EBT should complete an application and return it to the school for eligibility determination.
