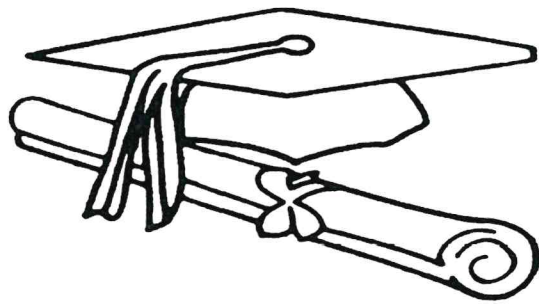
Former Ramsay students who are completing their senior year of high school are invited to walk the "halls of Ramsay School" at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 29th.


