WOW! Time is flying!!! It's already April.

The third quarter ends this Thursday, April 2nd. Report cards will be sent home with the students on Wednesday April 8th.

It is Ramsay School's policy that you must show proof of residency for your child to attend school at Ramsay. Attached is the form you need to fill out and return with an item listed to prove your residence. Only one per family is needed. Form and proof of residency are due back to the office by Wednesday, April 15th.

This gives us our student enrollment for the 2026/27 school year.

Dental Screening for grades K, 1st, 3rd, & 5th will take place Thursday, April 9th. Forms will be sent home at the end of this week. Thank you Dr. Gundersen for doing the screening for our school.

Out-of-district registration for Ramsay School is April 15th – June 5th. Current out-of-district students enrolled at Ramsay will have letters and applications mailed to them on April 9th, with return dates being April 15th – June 4th.

April 16th is the day for PreK *screening and registration from noon through 4 pm*. Screening times were sent to parents by Mr. Kellogg.

Kindergarten registration will also be taking place on April 16th. ***Kindergarten registration is set for 3:00 pm through 4:15 PM.***

Students will meet Mrs. Kelly and see the classroom.

Parents of students registering for PreK or Kindergarten need to bring along a copy of child's birth certificate, immunizations, and proof of residency (e.g., utility bill dated within 45 days, mortgage statement, property tax bill, homeowners or renter's insurance policy, or payroll statement, check or paystub dated within 45 days).

Students in 4th, 5th, and 6th grade are currently participating in Kindles for Kids. This program is sponsored by the Masons of Butte. Keep reading, do a book report, and turn into Mr. Kellogg by Thursday, April 30th. Every book report gets you a ticket for the Kindle drawing.
