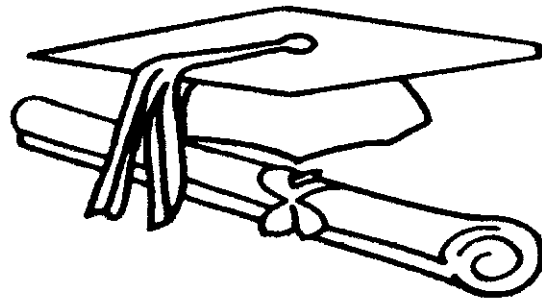

Attached to this newsletter is information for next year regarding the 2026/2027 school calendar, supply list, and bus routes.


